GMA Network names Amoroso as GMA Integrated News acting head

GMA Network appoints Oliver Victor B. Amoroso as Acting Head of the GMA Integrated News effective October 16, 2022. Amoroso will oversee the Network's Integrated News, which includes its on-air programs as well as its digital platform, GMA News Online.

Concurrently, he will continue to function as First Vice President and Head of Regional TV and Synergy. Amoroso is in charge of the operations, business development, and content and production – including local news, of GMA Network's regional arm, GMA Regional TV. As head of Synergy, he also leads the group that handles the Network's sports partnerships including GMA's coverage of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA). GMA Synergy also produces local and international ticketed events.

Meanwhile, after over 32 years of service in the Kapuso Network, Senior Vice President of GMA News and Public Affairs Marissa L. F or over 35 years, GMA Public Affairs has continued to be the leader in producing stories that impact Filipinos' lives: from investigative reports that tackle indepth discussions of issues, to magazine and reality programs that touch hearts, and to documentaries that open the public's eyes to shocking realities.

Like GMA Public Affairs, Jessica, Kara, Maki, Drew, and Atom are just some of the Kapuso broadcast journalists who have showcased what it means to create stories that are "Tatak Public Affairs," upholding truth in the age of fake news and misinformation.



JESSICA SOHO The Philippines' most awarded journalist

"Pag sinabi mong 'Tatak Public Affairs,' hindi lang tayo nagbabalita o nagkukwento. We want to change lives, one episode at a time."

Jessica is one of the main driving forces behind GMA Public Affairs. She conceptualized many iconic Kapuso public affairs shows, including Brigada Siete, Emergency, and I-Witness. She is also the Philippines' first recipient of the highly coveted George Foster Peabody Award and also the first and only Filipino broadcast journalist to have been nominated and won the bronze medal in the prestigious New York Festivals "World's Best TV and Films" Competition in the Best News Anchor category. Jessica remains one of the most trusted news personalities at the Reader's Digest Trusted Brands Awards 2022. She currently hosts the Filipinos' favorite Sunday viewing habit on TV, Kapuso Mo, Jessica Soho, which recently won as Top Media Publisher in 2022 TikTok Awards Philippines.



KARA DAVID The country's premiere documentarist

Kara has been praised for her documentaries that tug at the viewer's hearts. One of her documentaries for I-Witness, 'Ambulansyang de Paa," gave the Philippines its second George Foster Peabody Award. Aside from I-Witness, Kara currently hosts Pinas Sarap and Brigada. In 2011, Kara was included in the Ten Outstanding Women in the Nation's Service (TOWNS). She has been recently named as the new chair of the journalism department at the University of the Philippines College of Mass Communication.



MAKI PULIDO The fearless journalist

Maki is known for her passion for news and in-depth reporting. She currently co-anchors GTV's flagship evening newscast State of the Nation and co-hosts the internationallyacclaimed public affairs program Reporter's Notebook. Maki has earned numerous awards here and abroad for her stories in Reporter's Notebook. Her in-depth report "Backdoor" won the Silver Screen Award at the 2006 U.S. International Film & Video Festival. She also represented *Reporter's Notebook* at the 2007 Asian TV Awards where the show won Best Current Affairs program. In 2008, her story "Batang Kalakal" took home the Gold World Medal for Best Human Interest Story at the New York Festivals Television and Film Awards. This was followed by another gold medal in 2017 for her Reporter's Notebook episode "Pasan-Pasang Pangarap." In 2021, Reporter's Notebook won Best Public Service Program at the 42nd Catholic Mass Media Awards for her story "Mga Sugat ni Miguel" which also took home a New York Festivals medal.



n a way, Ms. Marissa L. Flores (MLF) represented a counterculture in television," wrote award-winning journalist and GMA News Pillar Howie Severino. "In an industry full of egos, she had next to none... It was not fame or fortune, but a steady application of bedrock values."

Starting as a researcher for public affairs documentaries and special reports in 1987, MLF rose from the ranks. Humility, values, excellence, and unwavering integrity are some of the words that keep coming back when people talk about MLF.

Under her leadership, the News and Public Affairs group continues to be the recipient of international awards and GMA remains as the only Philippine broadcast network which has won the highly-coveted Peabody Award –widely considered as broadcasting and cable's equivalent of the Pulitzer Prize. MLF also led the creation of GMA News Online, and the launch of GMA News TV, among others.

The Rotary Club of Manila recognized her as Television News Producer of the Year in 1996. In 2004, she was awarded the prestigious TOYM (The Outstanding Young Men) for Broadcast Management. In 2012, she received the CEO Excel Award from the International Association of Business Communicators (IABC) Philippines. MLF was recognized for her work in the field of broadcast journalism by the University of the Philippines College of Mass Communication at the first Glory Awards in 2017.

There are a few phrases that describe Ma'am Marissa best: Unquestionable integrity. Editorial sharpness. Journalistic ethics. Attention to detail. Devotion to production quality. Fairness. Humility. Unwavering faith in the "Walang Kinikilingan, Walang Pinoprotektahan, Serbisyong Totoo Lang" tagline that marks all our newscasts."

In many moments of management crisis over the years — everything from on air disasters to harassment cases to outright corruption, you name it, we've faced it — I would come to her office, sometimes in shock, sometimes in tears, asking what I should do. Her response was always something along the lines of "Find the truth" or "Tell the truth." Always ending with these words: "Do what is right." In a wide variety of situations, this consistent advice never failed.

I have been proud to work for this woman all these years because it simply was not possible for her to lead us astray. She herself would find the truth and tell the truth and do right by us on so many occasions.

She was proud of our every achievement. She took us to task, but kindly, for our many mistakes. Her retirement marks the end of an era, literally a golden era of GMA News and Public Affairs — the era of the four Peabody Awards, armfuls of New York Festival Medals, the Grand Prize at the Asian Academy Creative Awards, accolades for pioneering, top rating programs in so many different genres. She would say these were not hers but that of her people. But in so many ways, her values, her spirit — her life — has been at the heart of GMA News and Public Affairs' long success.

"CAN YOU DO IT?"

That was the million-peso question posed to me by MLF about possibly stepping into a bigger role for GMA News and Public Affairs. I'd had some success in my first couple of years within the organization, but what she was talking to me about meant an exponential increase in responsibilities.

She was never one for motivational speeches, but her guidance was there at every step: encouraging me, challenging me, and allowing me to take up the space as the digital person in a traditional television organization.

She did it not just for me, but for my whole team; she underscored our value and cherished our opinions, We will miss her leadership, and we will miss her brilliance. And we will be forever grateful for her faith in us.

Many organizations use "digital transformation" as a buzzword these days, but few really put their money where their mouths are. But MLF put her faith in us.

For January to September 2022, the top three programs of the network in NUTAM are all produced by News and Public Affairs (NAPA): 24 Oras, Lolong, and *Kapuso Mo, Jessica Soho.**

Our other programs in NAPA are also at the top of their game and even consistently win awards for the network, both here and abroad.

A constant by howie severino reminder of what really mattered

In a way, Marissa Flores represented a counterculture in television. In an industry full of egos, she had next to none. She had a simple lifestyle, kept a low profile, and rarely even wore makeup. She wasn't into selfies.

With her example, she kept us grounded, a constant reminder of what really mattered. It was not fame or fortune, but a steady application of bedrock values. Foremost were honesty and fairness. If you broke any rules, you'd hear from her in a firm but unthreatening manner. No matter how grave the violation, no one was shamed, especially in front of others. I've never heard her raise her voice, and say a mean thing about anybody, even privately.

In an environment that could have been toxic and cutthroat, she sought to create a humane place, where people cared about each other and helped one another when in need. Safety was a constant concern. From this wellspring of humanity one drew inspiration to strive and serve. ♥

The year was 1999 and I had just joined I-Witness as one of the hosts. Madaling araw ko na usually natatapos sa office yung pag-draft ng scripts para sa episode. At dahil wala pang Yahoo o Gmail dati, gigisingin ko si MLF ng mga 3 AM para i-proofread ang isinulat ko. Ang gawain namin, ilulusot ko yung script sa bakod sa labas ng old news room, tapos sasaluhin ni MLF sa kabila kasi malapit dun yung townhouse niya dati. Tapos ibabalik niya sa akin ober da bakod uli. Ganyan siya ka-hands on sa trabaho ever since.

I will also never forget how, after every remote coverage, she would text warm words of thanks for the hard work. These little gestures of appreciation always provided an energy boost. Nakakapawi talaga siya ng pagod para sa amin.

She never played favorites yet she had this way of making each of us feel na we were special and had something important to give to the news team. She was a dream boss who made us want to excel for all the right reasons.

WHAT DID I LEARN FROM MLF?

She taught us how to be fair and tough, yet kind and compassionate at the same time. She led with integrity and never left anyone behind, even during the most challenging of times.

ianne Valentin was on the Lalookout for a project that would test her acting skills when the role of a seductive and complex character named Stella in Apoy Sa Langit came her way.

Bringing Stella to life was the perfect challenge. Not only did Lianne have to give justice to the sole kontrabida character in the afternoon series, she also had to level up her acting game to match the performances of her more experienced co-actors. Despite the challenge, Lianne delivered more than what was expected of her. She turned in a convincing performance that people started recognizing her more as Stella than Lianne.

This was the moment that she had been waiting for all her life. When her moment came, she stepped into the spotlight and never looked back.

THE HUMBLE BEGINNINGS **OF LIANNE VALENTIN**

When Apoy Sa Langit premiered in May 2022, viewers thought Lianne was a rookie. What they didn't know was that Lianne had long started her career in showbiz as a child actor.

Lianne was discovered by director Louie Ignacio in a candy commercial. She first appeared on TV through a children's show called Tropang Potchi when she was 9. Some of Lianne's co-stars in Tropang Potchi were Bianca Umali, Miggs Cuaderno, Julian Trono, Ella Cruz, Sabrina Man, Miggy Jimenez, and Lenlen Frial.

Bigger and better projects eventually started coming her way. Lianne became part of GMA Network's highly successful shows like Mulawin vs. Ravena (2017), Kambal Karibal (2017), and Ang Dalawang Ikaw (2021). It was in 2022 she got her big break: the opportunity to star in the highlyrated GMA Afternoon Prime drama, Apoy sa Langit, sharing screen time with Maricel Laxa, Zoren Legaspi, and Mikee Quintos.

THE WAIT IS OVER

At the age of 21, Lianne accepted a challenging and daring role to show that she can be a force to be reckoned with. When she was handed the script, she knew right away that Stella was no ordinary character. "Noong nakuha ko, sabi ko hindi ko papalagpasin 'to. Hindi ko hahayaan na mag-slip lang 'tong role na 'to sa hands ko, kasi oo she's a kontrabida pero there's more to her. Malalim e, malalim 'yung pagkatao ni Stella."

Her determination and passion for her role didn't go unnoticed. During the early weeks of the series, Lianne started receiving both positive and negative remarks. Positive comments were made about her terrific performance as Stella. The negative comments, on the other hand, came from those who were greatly affected by Stella's evilness.

For those who don't know, Stella is the mistress of Cesar (Zoren Legaspi). In the drama series, Stella introduced herself to Cesar's new wife Gemma (Maricel Laxa) and stepdaughter Ning (Mikee Quintos) as his estranged daughter.

Lianne is grateful for the people who appreciate her performance in the show.

"Thank you sa mga nagagalingan sa akin. Hindi ko rin magagawa o hindi ko maisasabuhay si Stella kung hindi dahil sa tulong ng direktor namin, si Direk Laurice, na napakagaling na direktor at aktres. Siyempre si Ms. Ana Feleo na anak niya, na acting coach ko rin. Sila talaga 'yung mga tumulong sa akin."

The rising star of GMA also gives credit to her co-actors. According to Lianne, the scenes are always trending because of the talent and generosity of every actor in *Apoy sa Langit*. Itong pagiging aktres, pagacting, it's my passion. Alam ko na ibinigay itong talent sa akin ni Lord and I really want to use it."

"Pag nandoon ka na sa set at kaeksena mo na silang lahat, 'yung tipong nagbibigayan na kayo pagdating sa pag-arte, sobrang sarap sa feeling. 'Yun nga nagpapadala lang ako sa mga co-actors ko."

WHAT'S NEXT AFTER APOY SA LANGIT

She is humbled and honored that she was able to showcase her talent in a project that she can be proud of for a long time.

"Very grateful rin ako sa management na pinagkatiwalaan nila ako ng ganitong klaseng kabigat at kaganda na role." Lianne knows that not many aspiring actors are given the chance to be part of worthwhile projects. "Maraming gustong mag-artista, pero hindi lahat ng tao nabibigyan ng opportunity. Kaya noong nabigyan ako ng opportunity na 'to talagang sabi ko hindi ko palalampasin, and 'yun nga, I want to make every fan and supporter proud of me."

With Lianne's determination and passion, she promises to continue to do her best in the next projects that GMA would give her.

The workshop was facilitated by multi-awarded environmental leader Ms. Anna Oposa, Chief Mermaid and Executive Director of Save Philippine Seas. She discussed the country's waste management crisis and gave ways on addressing this such as the 4Rs (Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, and Role) initiative, and supporting sustainability programs.

Sanya shared her commitment in doing eco-friendly practices at home, "Simple lang ginagawa ko pero I think nakaka-help siya. I segregate biodegradables from non-biodegradables. Also, 'nung bata ako mahilig ako mag-plant kaya ginagamit ko uli 'yung bottle na itatapon na. Pinipinturahan ko ito at ginagawang lagayan ng mga plant namin. Makakatipid ako kasi 'di ko na kailangan pang bumili."

Bianca expressed her view as an artist in promoting sustainability and waste management, "My role as an artist in the promotion of sustainability is the platforms and the voice that I am given. It's more of being aware of how I will be able to use this platform and this voice to be informative and to bring awareness to the people who look up to me and support me, especially the youth. It's a big responsibility to have that power, to be able to share and teach them my simple ways of how I help in sustainability. What we can teach them now, is what they will do in the future for us."

For Sofia, the biggest waste we produce are plastics, "Plastics po, 'yung mga bina-buy ko po sa mall." Anjay shared same sentiments, "Ganun din po mga food packaging and face masks."

Allen revealed that he repurposes trash as his way of saving the environment, "Nung highschool ako, lagi kaming nag-rerecycle ng mga basura. Gumagawa kami ng mga parol gawa sa plastic na basura." Aside from this, they also have an environmental tradition in their province, "Sa probinsya, every year lahat ng mga teenager, mommy at daddy, tulong-tulong maglinis. 'Yung harap po namin sa probinsya is dagat and puntahan po kami ng mga nagbabakasyon kaya ang ginagawa namin, bawat resort nilalagyan namin ng mga sako para maiwasan 'yung mga basura. Kasi tuwing nagkakabagyo, sa amin napupunta 'yung mga basura."

Meanwhile, Kirsten also shared how she can motivate others to practice these ways, "I think yung role ko po as an artist is to share information po. So being able to share it sa mga platform naming artist, we will be able to give meaning kung bakit namin ginagawa yung mga bagay for the environment po."

Apart from workshops, the *Kapuso at Kasambuhay ng Kalikasan* will also include advocacy videos headlined by Sparkle artists, on-ground volunteer activities, and online environmental education modules.
